UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

1. The Chief Secretary, State of Punjab and the Director General of Police, State of Punjab, have filed their respective Compliance Reports-cum-Affidavits.
2. In para 5 of the Compliance Report, filed on behalf of the Chief Secretary, State of Punjab, which pertains to the medical examination of Shri Jagjit Singh Dallewal, sub-para (iii) refers to a comparative chart of clinical investigations based on the blood samples taken on 19.12.2024, 24.12.2024, 30.12.2024, 03.01.2025, 09.01.2025 and 14.01.2025.
3. We direct the Chief Secretary, State of Punjab to hand over a xerox copy of complete set of these Reports, to enable this Court to take an opinion about the medical/health condition of Shri Jagjit Singh Dallewal from the Medical Board that may be asked to be constituted by the Director, All India Institute of Medical Sciences, New Delhi (AIIMS).
4. The xerox copy of complete set of these Reports shall be submitted to the Registrar (Judicial) of this Court during the course of day, who shall then co-ordinate with the Director, AIIMS, and obtain the opinion of experts based upon such Reports.
5. Meanwhile, Mr. Kapil Sibal, learned Senior Counsel, representing the respondents, has submitted that some effective steps have taken; there is a progress in the matter and what he indicates is that the Authorities are hopeful of a solution.
6. Learned Advocate General for the State of Punjab, who is present in Court, also states to the same effect.
7. Post the matter for further consideration on 22.01.2025.
