UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

By way of this petition under Article 32 of the
Constitution of India, following reliefs are sought-

"1. For a writ of mandamus or any other appropriate writ, order or direction to the Union of India and all the States and Union Territories to provide homeless persons in or around all the shelter homes set up by the the Municipalities or any other authorities or public body and also all the place of residence or temporary occupation of the homeless people in every district, with three nutritious and adequate meals every-day during the entire Pandemic Period;

2. For an order to all the respondents to ensure that the entitlements mandated by the National Food Security Act, 2013 are provided to all homeless people in or around all the shelter homes and also

all the places of residence or temporary occupation of the homeless people, pregnant and lactating women members of their families as well as all children of their families in compliance to the provisions of Sections 3, 4, 5, 6 and 8 of the National Food Security Act, 2013 as well as in conformity with the nutritional standards stipulated in Schedule II of the Act through the existing network of PDS shops, Anganwadis and Schools;

3. For an order directing the respondents to provide soaps, detergents, hand sanitizers, hand wash and masks to the homeless persons in shelter homes set up by the respondents or the Municipalities or any other authorities or public body and also all the places of residence or temporary occupation of the homeless people;

4. For any such order/directions that this Hon'ble Court may deem fit."

From the aforesaid, it can be seen that the reliefs sought were for the period during Covid-19 pandemic. Therefore, by efflux of time and in view of the subsequent development, the present Writ Petition for the aforesaid reliefs has become infructuous. Keeping other questions open, to be considered in the pending proceedings, we dispose of the present Writ Petition.

The Writ Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
