O R D E R

1. Learned ASG states that the matter regarding shifting of the Tribunal through a makeshift arrangement is at the final stage and an appropriate decision in this regard will be taken within two weeks.

2. The petitioner-in-person has pointed out and very rightly so that there is a scarcity of assisting staff, more importantly, the Stenographers.

3. In this regard, the Union Government may think of hiring the services of (i) retired personnel and/or (ii) willing staff on deputation. Alternatively, an advertisement may be issued for contractual engagements till the selection process for regular appointments is finalised. A compliance report in this regard shall also be filed.

4. Post the matter on 15.12.2025.
