ORDER

15.01.2025

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1. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the North East Riot Delhi Commission has rendered findings and made recommendations *qua* the claims in respect of 14 out of present batch of 19 petitions.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that although the amount assessed and recommended by the North East Riot Delhi Commission is a fraction of what the petitioners in these cases are entitled, at the very least, directions should be issued to GNCTD for release of the recommended amount at the earliest.
3. The said request is not opposed by learned counsel for the respondent no.2.
4. Accordingly, the respondent no.2 is directed to release the amount recommended by the North East Riot Delhi Commission *qua* the petitioners in the present batch of cases. Let the requisite amount be released within a period of eight weeks from today.
5. Needless to say, the same shall be without the rights and contentions



of the petitioners in these petitions.
