Heard on the question of admission and interim relief.

Issue notice to the respondents on payment of process fee within seven working days by speed post, returnable in four weeks, failing which the writ petition shall stand dismissed without reference to the Bench.

The petitioner has placed reliance on Writ Petition No. 44313 of 2025 which is identical to the case of the petitioner.

It is contended by the petitioner that the issue raised in the present petition and the reliefs claimed herein are identical to the said case. In the said case also this Court has entertained the petition and passed the following order :-

"Heard on the question of admission and interim relief.

Issue notice.

Shri Shreyraj Saxena, Dy. A.G. accepts notice on behalf of respondents/State and prays for and is granted six weeks time to file reply.

In the meanwhile, respondent No.3 is directed to return the original documents along with the objection certificate to the petitioner on due acknowledgment and the same shall remain subject to final outcome of

this petition.
List after six weeks."

In order to maintain parity with the case relied upon by the petitioner, it is directed that the respondents No.3 shall return the original documents along with the objection Certificate to the petitioner on due acknowledgement and the same shall be subject to final outcome of this petition.

List the matter along with Writ Petition No. 44313 of 2025.

However, it is directed that looking to the urgency in the matter, the respondents are directed to return the said original documents latest by 23.02.2026.
