During the course of arguments today, the Court has been informed the challan was presented in the present case on 31.07.2021 and since then, the case is listed for framing of charge. This Court is of *prima facie* opinion that the judicial officer, who is handling the trial as well as the public prosecutor, who is handling the matter, are highly negligent in performing their duties.

The concerned Judicial officer is directed to explain as to how the trial has been delayed for a period of 5 years. The concerned public prosecutor as well as the District Attorney, Gurugram are directed to remain present in the Court, on the next date of hearing.

A copy of this order may be also forwarded to the Commissioner of Police, Gurugram as well as the Sessions Judge, Gurugram to ensure that the trial in the present case is expedited.
