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DR. TANWI SHAMS

Assistant Professor of Law, National
Law University Odisha



Dr. Tanwi Shams is currently serving as an Assistant Professor of Law and Director of the Centre for Disability Law and Advocacy at National Law University Odisha, India. She holds an LL.M. in Intellectual Property and Technology Law from the National University of Singapore and is the recipient of the prestigious Lee Kong Chian Graduate Scholarship for pursuing her LL.M., and she holds a Ph.D. in Human Rights Law from North-Eastern Hill University, Shillong.

A recipient of two major research projects funded by the Indian Council of Social Science Research (ICSSR), Dr. Shams serves as both Principal Investigator and Co-Investigator. Her teaching and research interests include Intellectual Property Rights, Artificial Intelligence, and Human Rights Law. Committed to inclusivity and social empowerment, she advances scholarship and advocacy at the intersection of law, technology, and human rights.

Ms. Sanskruti Samal is an independent legal practitioner appearing primarily before the Supreme Court of India and other appellate courts. A 2018 graduate, she secured Rank 2 in the Supreme Court Law Clerk-cum-Research Assistant Examination and served as Law Clerk to Justice N. V. Ramana (2018–2021), later being appointed Consultant to the Chief Justice of India (2021–2022).
