It is the grievance of the petitioner that the petitioner as a contractor, worked as given by Municipal Council, Bhind from time to time. He refers letter dated 05.02.2026 issued by C.M.O, Municipal Council, Bhind where despite the amount being admitted, it has been mentioned that due to paucity of funds in Municipal Council, Bhind, the payment is not made and whenever the amount is available, the amount as sought by the petitioner, shall be paid.

It is specific submission of counsel for the petitioner that most of the works are related to year 2014 to 2017. Still the payment has not been made.

The facts, if are correct, then, it depicts sorry state of affairs.

Issue notice to the respondents on payment of process fee by RAD mode within Three working days, returnable within four weeks.

On the next date of hearing, Chief Municipal Officer as well as President of Municipal Council, Bhind, both shall file affidavits about the particulars of different payments made to different people between 2014 till today, so as to verify the facts as mentioned by C.M.O in it's letter dated 05.02.2026.

At this stage, Shri S.P.Jain Advocate, appeared on behalf of both the

respondents and accepts notice. Two sets of petition along with annexures be provided to Shri S.P. Jain Advocate.

Since he accepts notice, therefore, payment of PF is dispensed with.

Office is directed to reflect the name of Shri S.P.Jain Advocate on behalf of respondents in the cause list.

List this matter on 10th March, 2026.
