Heard Shri Anuj Kudesia, Senior Advocate assisted by Shri Prabal Harsh and Shri Abhishek Tiwari, Advocates, the learned counsel for the petitioner, Shri Sudeep Kumar, Senior Advocate assisted by Shri Shreshth Srivastava, Shri Ashutosh Kumar, and Ms. Trisha, Advocates, the learned counsel for the opposite parties no.3 and 4 and Shri Prashant Kumar Srivastava, the learned counsel for the opposite party no.1-Canara Bank.

The matter was listed today under the heading "Hon'ble Supreme Court expedited matters" and it was pointed out that on 25.08.2025 while remanding the matter to this Court the Hon'ble Supreme Court had requested to decide the petition as early as possible, preferably within six months. The period of six months is expiring today. Today there were 92 fresh matters, 101 regular matters, 39 fresh misc. applications and three matters listed in the additional/unlisted list-I, II and III. Only fresh cases upto serial number 29 could be heard today.
