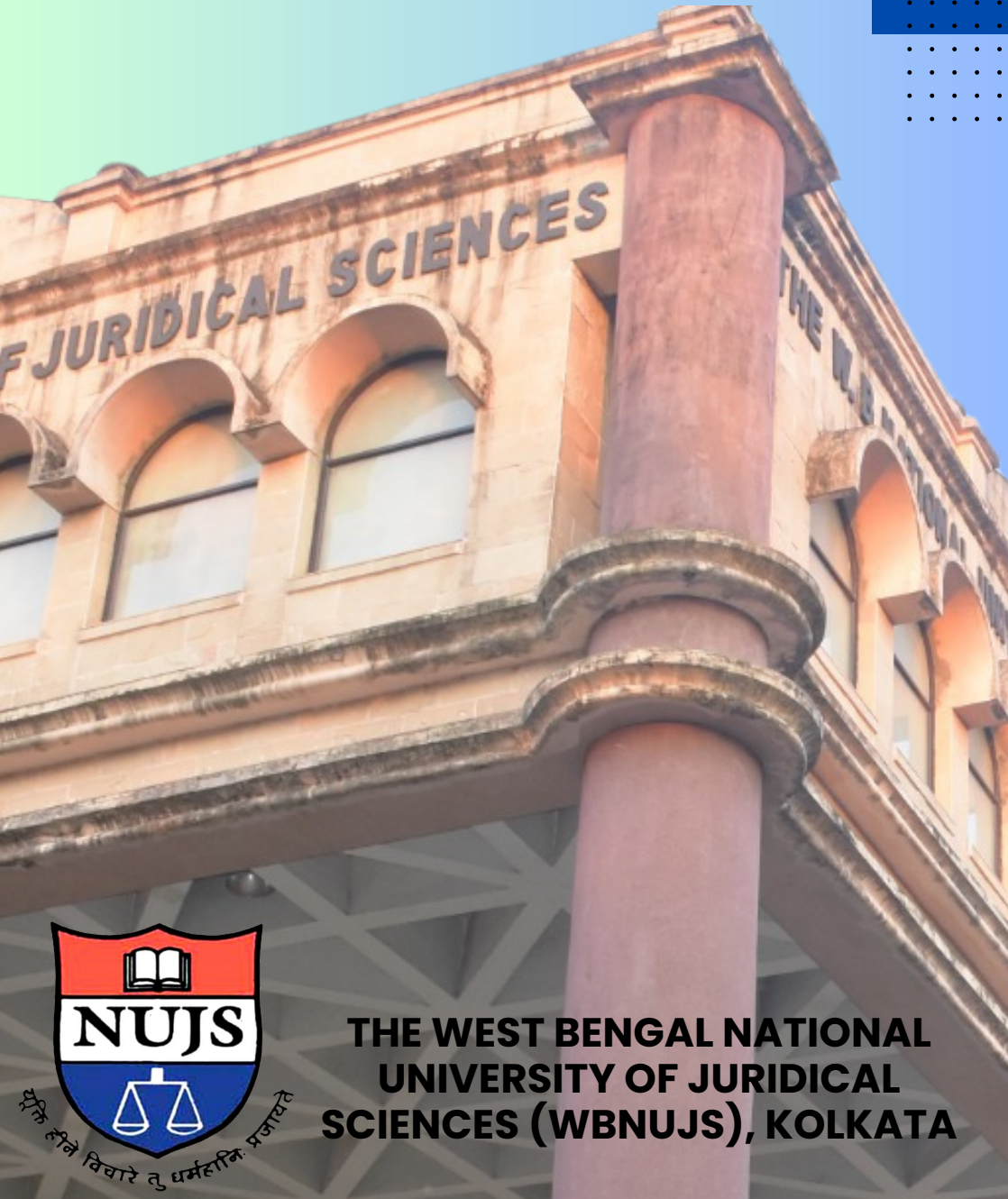
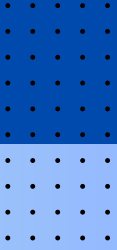




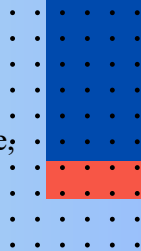

ABOUT WBNUJS

The West Bengal National University of Juridical Sciences (WBNUJS), Kolkata, was established under the WBNUJS Act, 1999 (West Bengal Act IX of 1999). Recognized under sub-section 2(f) and section 12(b) by the University Grants Commission (UGC), its B.A. LL.B (Hons.) and BSc. LL.B (Hons.) programs are affiliated with the Bar Council of India. The Hon'ble Chief Justice of India serves as the Chancellor of the University and Chairman of its highest governing body, the General Council. Despite its relatively short existence, WBNUJS has firmly established itself as one of India's premier national law universities. It ranked 4th in the NIRF India Ranking 2025 under the Law category and received the prestigious SILF-MILAT Institutional Excellence Award in 2015 for its contribution to legal education. Additionally, NUJS was honored with the "Ananda Purashkar" by ABP Ananda as the Best Innovative Institution in West Bengal.

M.A. IN CRIMINOLOGY AND CRIMINAL JUSTICE ADMINISTRATION

The M.A. in Criminology and Criminal Justice Administration is a two-year Master's Degree Program. The program can be availed by a graduate holding a Bachelor's degree in any discipline with a minimum of 55% marks from any recognised University in India or abroad. It covers advanced areas such as:

- Victimology & Victim Assistance
- Criminal Psychology & Criminal Behaviour
- Comparative & Cultural Criminology
- Cyber Criminology & Cyber Forensics
- Geriatric & Youth Criminology
- Emerging Trends in Policing

Candidates qualifying in the Admission test and Personal Interview (PI) will be entitled to get admission for the Master's Programme. Candidates awaiting final results may apply provisionally.

Examination (NUJS- PGET)

The examination will consist of a 100 MCQ-based assessment (50 marks Aptitude test and 50 marks Domain Knowledge). Each Question carries 1 mark, with a negative marking of 0.25 for every incorrect answer. The duration of the examination will be 90 minutes. The merit list shall be prepared on the basis of the entrance examination and a personal interview (hybrid mode).

The sanctioned intake strength for M.A. in Criminology and Criminal Justice Administration is 50 seats.

M.SC. IN FORENSIC SCIENCE

The Master of Science (M.Sc.) in Forensic Science is an advanced academic degree program designed to equip students with the theoretical knowledge and practical skills required to work in the field of forensic science. This program is highly interdisciplinary, integrating various scientific disciplines such as biology, chemistry, physics, and computer science with the principles of criminal justice. It covers advanced areas such as:

- Forensic Biological Sciences
- Forensic Chemical Sciences
- Forensic Physical Sciences
- Crime Scene Investigation and Evidence Management
- Relevant Legal Methods for Forensic Proceedings
- Fingerprints and other impressions
- Digital & Cyber Forensics

The program can be availed by a graduate holding B.Sc./B.Sc. (Hons.) Degree with a minimum of 55% marks from any recognised university in India or abroad.

Candidates qualifying in the Admission test and Personal Interview (PI) will be entitled to get admission for the Master's Programme. Candidates awaiting final results may apply provisionally.

Examination (NUJS- PGET)

The examination will consist of a 100 MCQ-based assessment (50 marks Aptitude test and 50 marks Domain Knowledge). Each Question carries 1 mark, with a negative marking of 0.25 for every incorrect answer. The duration of the examination will be 90 minutes. The merit list shall be prepared on the basis of the entrance examination and a personal interview (hybrid mode).

The sanctioned intake strength for M.Sc. in Forensic Science programme is 30 seats.

LL.M. IN DATA SCIENCE AND DATA PROTECTION LAW

The LL.M in Data Science and Data Protection Law is an innovative Post-graduate program that integrates legal studies with data science and technology. This program equips legal professionals with technical expertise to navigate the complex intersection of law, data, and emerging technologies. Through a unique combination of data science methodologies and legal principles, students will learn to analyze, interpret, and govern data-driven systems while ensuring compliance with evolving regulatory frameworks. It covers advanced areas such as:

- Data Science for Legal Applications
- Legal-Tech Integration
- Technical Implementation of Privacy Laws

The program can be availed by a graduate holding a bachelor's degree in Law with at least 55% marks from any recognised university in India or abroad.

Candidates qualifying in the Admission test and Personal Interview (PI) will be entitled to get admission for the Master's Programme. Candidates awaiting final results may apply provisionally.

Examination (NUJS- PGET)

The examination will consist of a 100 MCQ-based assessment (50 marks Aptitude test and 50 marks Domain Knowledge). Each Question carries 1 mark, with a negative marking of 0.25 for every incorrect answer. The duration of the examination will be 90 minutes. The merit list shall be prepared on the basis of the entrance examination and a personal interview (hybrid mode).

The sanctioned intake strength for LL.M. in Data Science and Data Protection Law is 40 seats.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- **Duration:** 2 years (4 semesters).
- **Medium of instruction:** English
- **Reservation:** 5%-mark relaxation will be for SC/ST candidates. Reservation Policy will be applied as per West Bengal State Government norms.
- **Provisional Admission:** Candidates awaiting final results may apply provisionally. Provisional admission will be revoked if the final degree certificate is not submitted within two months from the commencement of the first semester classes.
- **Admission Test:** All admissions to these courses will be through **NUJS-PGET**, the All-India Entrance Test to be held on **March 29, 2026**, at Kolkata, Bhopal, Guwahati, Hyderabad, Chennai, Delhi, and Mumbai (Test Centers will be notified in due course).
