

**GURSHARANJOT SINGH RANDHAWA @ GURU RANDHAWA VS
RAJDEEP SINGH MANN AND OTHERS**

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in the present case the respondent has filed a complaint against the petitioner for the commission of offence punishable under Sections 299, 302, 196, 356(1), 356(2) & 353 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, and that in the above-mentioned case without recording the preliminary evidence the notice has been issued to the petitioner, which is contrary to the scheme prescribed under Section 223 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita. The copy of order dated 25.08.2025 is available on record as Annexure P-2. The above-mentioned order reads as under:-

“Complaint presented today. It be registered.

Let, notice under Section 223 of BNSS on filing
RC/AD be issued for 02.09.2025.”

The above-mentioned order makes it apparent that the notice to the petitioner/accused has been issued without recording the preliminary evidence.

In the meantime proceedings before the learned trial Court shall remain stayed.
