UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. In continuation of our dated 29.05.2026, Union of India has filed an affidavit indicating planning and progress that has been made about conducting examinations through National Testing Agency

(NTA) with professionalism and integrity. We have conveyed to the learned Solicitor General that this Court is concerned about institutionalisation of the NTA, for which it shall monitor implementation of the suggestions by Dr. K. Radhakrishnan Committee, as considered and if necessary modified by Nandan Nilekani Committee.

2. We have been informed that the Nandan Nilekani Committee is constituted to recommend end to end reforms focusing on leveraging advance technology like artificial intelligence/block chain etc. to strengthen security and integrity in the conduct of examinations. Learned Solicitor General has conveyed to us that the Nandan Nilekani Committee has convened a meeting to address various issues.

3. An affidavit filed on behalf of the petitioners giving certain suggestions is already handed over to the learned Solicitor General. The suggestions given therein may be placed before the Committee for its consideration.

4. We direct the Secretary, Ministry of Education to file a detailed affidavit indicating the process in the implementation of Dr. K. Radhakrishnan Committee report. The affidavit with necessary details shall be filed within a period of three weeks from today.
