The matter was reserved for delivery of judgment on August 17, 2026. On August 18, 2026, when I was in the Court room, one of the learned counsels for the petitioner alongwith my private secretary, in collusion and connivance with each other, went to my chamber and asked my staff present outside the chamber to bring out the record of this matter, which was refused by my staff. They tried to enter my chamber and insisted on seeing the record which was again resisted by my staff. Such conduct of the learned counsel and the private secretary is seriously deprecated, moreso, since it smells of an oblique motive on their part.

In view of such deliberate attempt made by them, this Court finds it appropriate to release the matter.

The matter is released on the grounds stated hereinabove.

The matter be placed before the Hon'ble the Acting Chief Justice, High Court, Calcutta for appropriate directions.
