In order to enable this Court to have complete information, we call upon NALSA to state about the number of cases under the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005; (initiated till date and pending) and in how many cases the services of Protection Officer/Service Provider or shelter homes were required to be extended.

In order to elicit details in this behalf, NALSA may send an appropriate questionnaire to the State Legal Services Authorities and obtain requisite information.
