Order

Reportable

1. Since common question of law and facts are involved in these petitions, therefore, with the consent of counsel for the parties, all the matters are taken up together for final disposal at this stage.

2. All the petitioners have approached this Court by way of filing of these petitions under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking directions against the respondents to grant them annual grade increment for the services rendered by them from 1st July to 30th June and consequently, re-fix their pensionary benefits.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the controversy involved in these petitions has already been set at rest by this Court in batch of petitions with lead case being **S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.21/2020** titled as **Vijay Singh vs. State of Rajasthan & Ors.** decided on 21.07.2023. Counsel submits that the aforesaid judgment was not challenged by the State before the higher Appellate Forum and that the State has taken a decision to comply with the directions issued by this Court. Hence, under these circumstances, the judgment passed by this court in the case of **Vijay Singh** (supra) has attained finality. Counsel submits that all these petitions be disposed of, in the light of the judgment passed by this Court in the case of **Vijay Singh** (supra) and similar directions be issued in these writ petitions as well.

4. This fact is not in dispute that the controversy involved in all these petitions has already been decided by this Court



in the case of **Vijay Singh** (Supra) with the following observations and directions in para 30 to 42 which reads as under:-

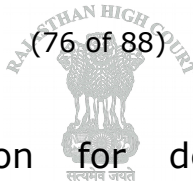


"30. Payment of salary and increment to an employee is regulated by the service rules governing his/her services. Annual increment are given to such persons to enable them to discharge the duties to the post and that pay and allowances are also attached to the post. Increment in pay is thus an integral part of progressive appointment and accrues from the day following on which it is earned.

31. There is a purpose for providing that increment earned accrues from the day following which it is earned. The grant of increment is not a matter of course and is dependent upon good conduct of the government servant for the entire year. It is, therefore natural that good conduct must be observed for the entire year before the increment accrues.

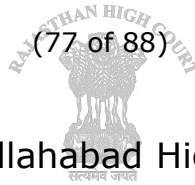
32. Annual increment though is attached to the post and becomes payable on a day following which it is earned but the day on which increment accrues or becomes payable is not conclusive or determinative. In the statutory scheme governing progressive appointment increment becomes due for the services rendered over a year by the government servant subject to his good behaviour. The pay of a government servant rises, by periodical increments, from a minimum to the maximum in the prescribed scale. The entitlement to receive increment therefore crystallises when the government servant completes requisite length of service with good conduct and becomes payable on the succeeding day.

33. Law is settled that where entitlement to receive a benefit crystallizes in law its denial would be arbitrary unless it is for a valid reason.



The only reason for denying benefit of increment, culled out from the scheme is that the government servant is not holding the post on the day when the increment becomes payable. This cannot be a valid ground for denying increment since the day following the date on which increment is earned only serves the purpose of ensuring completion of a year's service with good conduct and no other purpose can be culled out for it. The concept of day following which the increment is earned has otherwise no purpose to achieve. In isolation of the purpose it serves, the fixation of day succeeding the date of entitlement has no intelligible differentia nor any object is to be achieved by it. The government servant retiring on 30th June has already completed a year of service and the increment has been earned provided his conduct was good. It would thus be wholly arbitrary, if the increment earned by the government employee on the basis of his good conduct for a year is denied only because the reason stated hereinabove. In the present case the scheme for payment of increment would have to be read as whole and one part of Rule 14 and 13 of the Rules of 2008 and Rules of 2017 respectively cannot be read in isolation so as to frustrate the other part, particularly when the other part creates right in the government servant to receive increment. This would ensure that scheme of progressive appointment remains intact and the rights earned by a government servant remains protected and are not denied due to a fortuitous circumstance.

34. In *P. Ayyamperumal* (supra) the Madras High Court held that once the employees had completed one full year of service as on 30th June, the benefit of increment earned on the basis of completed service of one year cannot be denied because such increment fell due on 1st July and by that time the employee had retired. The judgment of *P. Ayyamperumal* (supra) has attained finality till Apex Court. Subsequently, this judgment was followed by the Delhi High Court in the case of *Gopal Singh*

(supra), by the Allahabad High Court in the case of P.P. Pandey Vs. State of U.P. reported in (2021) ILR 1 All. 882 and in the case of NandVijay Singh (supra) and the Hon'ble Apex Court has considered almost each and every judgments of all High Courts in the case of All India Judges Association (supra) and in the case of C.P.Mundinamani (supra).



35.Controversy involved in these petitions has been put at rest by the Hon'ble Supreme Court by putting seal in the above two cases. Thus, the doctrine of finality has to be applied in a strict legal sense. Judicial propriety and decorum demands that the law laid down by the highest Court of the land must be given effect to.

36.In the country governed by the Rule of Law, the finality of a judgment is absolutely imperative and it is not permissible for the parties to re open the concluded judgments of the Court. It would also nullify the doctrine of 'stare decisis' a well settled valuable principle of precedent which cannot be departed from unless there are compelling reasons to do so. The judgments of the Court and particularly Apex Court of a country cannot and should not be unsettled lightly.

37.The hallmark of a judicial pronouncement is its stability and finality. Judicial verdicts are not like sand dunes which are subject to the vagaries of wind and weather.

38.Thus, it is not permissible for the parties to re open the concluded judgments as the same may not only tantamount to an abuse of the process of law and Court but would have far reaching adverse effect on the administration of justice.

39.When the position of law is almost identical everywhere in the other States and when the benefit of Annual Increment is given to such employees like the petitioners, then denial of



such benefits to the petitioners would amount to violation of their right of equality enshrined under Article 14 of the Constitution of India.

40. Since all the judgments of various High Courts and Hon'ble Apex Court were not brought into the notice of Division Bench of this Court at the time of decision of Safi Mohd.(supra) and after the decision of the case of Safi Mohd. (supra), two judgments have been delivered by the Hon'ble Apex Court in the case of C.P. Mundinamani(supra) and All India Judges Association(supra) in favour of the employees like the petitioners by holding that the persons would be entitled to get benefits of annual increments even on the day of their retirement i.e. on 30th June. Hence, under the change circumstances the petitioners are also entitled for the same benefits.

41. Hence, looking to the binding effect of above judgment of Hon'ble Apex Court in the case of C.P. Mundinamani(supra) and All India Judges Association (supra), it is held that the petitioners would be entitled to get the benefits of increment falling due on 1st July on account of their conduct for the requisite length of time i.e. one year. The petitioners would be entitled to get notional payment on 1st July, notwithstanding their superannuation on 30th June.

42. The respondents are directed to consider the case of the petitioners afresh in the light of the observations made hereinabove and thereafter grant notional increment to the petitioners. The petitioners' pension would consequently be refixed. The appropriate orders be issued and the arrears of pension be paid to the petitioners within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order."

5. This Court has noticed that after the disposal of the issue involved in these petitions on earlier occasion in the





case of **Vijay Singh** (supra), thousands of identical petitions have been filed by the aggrieved persons seeking similar orders and also for disposal of their petitions in the light of the orders/directions passed in the case of **Vijay Singh** (supra).



6. It appears that before making declaration in the Budget Speech, the Government was treating judgment of **Vijay Singh** (supra) '*in personam*' and the same was not treated as a judgment '*in rem*'. Such action of the respondent-Government has opened the flood gates for all the aggrieved persons to approach this Court again and again seeking same orders.

7. Once, the judgment has been passed by this Court in the case of **Vijay Singh** (supra) and the same has been accepted by the Government by not challenging the same before any Appellate Forum, hence under these circumstances, the respondents are duty bound to comply the directions/orders issued in the case of **Vijay Singh** (supra) in letter and spirit.

8. Subsequently, a question came up for consideration of this Court is "whether the benefits which have been given to the similarly situated persons by this Court in the case of **Vijay Singh** (supra) can be given to the present petitioners and also to those persons who have not approached this Court by way of filing of any petitions".

9. Taking serious note of the above situation, this Court has decided a bunch of writ petitions with the lead case of **Ramesh Chandra Sharma Vs. State of Rajasthan and**



Ors. in S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.10939/2024 and the same was disposed of on 15.07.2024 with the following observations and directions in the para 16 to 19 which reads as under:-



"16. It is settled proposition of law that when a judgment is pronounced by the Court, affecting the rights of public at large, then the said judgment should be treated as a judgment 'in rem' with intention to give benefit to all similarly situated persons whether they approached this Court or not. With such a pronouncement, the obligation is casted upon the authorities to itself extend the benefit thereof to all similarly situated persons. The judgment passed by this Court in the case of **Vijay Singh** (supra) can be treated as a judgment "*in rem*" and not "*in personam*" henceforth. The respondents are directed to grant all the benefits issued by this Court in the case of **Vijay Singh** (supra) to all similarly situated aggrieved persons without compelling them to approach this Court again and again for getting similar orders.

17. For this purpose, the petitioners and all similarly placed persons may approach the Secretary or the Head of their respective departments by way of filing appropriate representations for redressal of their grievances. The Secretary and the Head of the respective department are expected to consider the case and refer the same to the Department of Finance for taking appropriate decision in the light of judgment passed by this Court in the case of **Vijay Singh** (supra).

18. It goes without saying that whenever a representation is submitted to the Secretary or to the Head of the Department, it is expected from them to consider the same immediately and to decide the same expeditiously, as early as possible, preferably within a period of three months from the date of receiving the representation. It is made clear that in case, any wilful disobedience is made by the



respondents in compliance of the orders passed by this Court, then the same would be viewed seriously and would amount to contempt of Court and appropriate proceedings would be initiated against the person concerned who is liable for the same.

19. It goes without saying that the persons who have not approached this Court are not supposed to approach this Court and they may straightaway approach the Department concerned by way of filing representations and it is expected from the Departments to decide the same in the light of the judgment passed by this Court in the case of **Vijay Singh** (supra)."

10. Since the controversy involved in these petitions has been settled twice by this Court in the case of **Vijay Singh** (supra) and **Ramesh Chandra Sharma** (supra), and it has specifically been held in the case of **Ramesh Chandra Sharma** (supra) that "those persons who have not approached this Court are not supposed to approach this Court and they may straightaway approach the Department concerned by way of filing representation and it is expected from the Department to decide the same in the light of the judgment passed by this Court in the case of **Vijay Singh** (supra)".

11. In the case of **K.I. Shephard and Ors vs. Union of India and Ors** reported in 1987 (4) SCC 431, Hon'ble Apex Court has held that the employees who had not come to the Court should not be penalized for not having litigated and would be entitled to the same benefits as the petitioners in that case. It has also been held that the excluded employees, who had not approached the





Court, shall also be entitled to the same benefits, as the petitioners in that case were entitled under the judgment of that case.

12. The principle laid down in **K.I. Shephard** (supra) that it is not necessary for every person to approach the court for relief, and it is the duty of the authority to extend the benefit of a concluded decision in all similar cases without driving every affected person to Court to seek relief would apply only in the following circumstances:

- a) where the order is made in a petition filed in a representative capacity on behalf of all similarly situated employees;
- b) where the relief granted by the Court is a declaratory relief which is intended to apply to all employees in a particular category, irrespective of whether they are parties to the litigation or not;
- c) where an order or rule of general application to employees is quashed without any condition or reservation that the relief is restricted to the petitioners before the court; and
- d) where the court expressly directs that the relief granted should be extended to those who have not approached the court.

13. Repeated petitions, filed by the litigants for the same common cause of action and for redressal of same grievance, amount to abuse of the process when general directions are already issued by the Court in favour of one and all, by issuing directions to the Government authorities for providing the same benefits to all the aggrieved persons. Then such person are not expected to knock the



doors of the Court again by filing similar petitions with the same prayers.

14. The sanctity of the judicial order is required to be eroded seriously and any attempt of misuse of the process is required to be dealt firmly. The valuable time of other litigants should not be allowed to be taken by such litigants, such similarly situated litigants should not be allowed to misuse the judicial leniency.

15. Courts are choked with several kinds of litigation. Filing of similar, repeated, identical and groundless petitions constitute a serious menace to the administration of justice. They consume time and clog the infrastructure. Productive resources which should be deployed in the handling of genuine causes are dissipated in attending the cases filed only to get similar relief which has already been granted by making the judgment in rem. Filing of such similar petitions for worthless cause amounts to gross abuse of the process of law and wastage of valuable time of the Court.

15.1 Unfortunately, as this batch of similar and identical writ petitions exemplifies, the process of dispensing justice is misused by the unscrupulous to the detriment of the legitimate. This batch of petitions is an illustration of how a decided issue has occupied the time of the Court and how successive similar petitions are filed unnecessarily to consume the time of other litigants who are waiting for hearing and disposal of their cases.





15.2 Taking such situation seriously, the Hon'ble Apex Court in the case of **Dnyandeo Sabaji Naik and another vs. Pradnya Prakash Khandekar and others** reported in 2017 (5) SCC 496 has held in para 13 and 14 as under:



"13. This Court must view with disfavour any attempt by a litigant to abuse the process. The sanctity of the judicial process will be seriously eroded if such attempts are not dealt with firmly. A litigant who takes liberties with the truth or with the procedures of the Court should be left in no doubt about the consequences to follow. Others should not venture along the same path in the hope or on a misplaced expectation of judicial leniency. Exemplary costs are inevitable, and even necessary, in order to ensure that in litigation, as in the law which is practised in our country, there is no premium on the truth.

14. Courts across the legal system - this Court not being an exception - are choked with litigation. Frivolous and groundless filings constitute a serious menace to the administration of justice. They consume time and clog the infrastructure. Productive resources which should be deployed in the handling of genuine causes are dissipated in attending to cases filed only to benefit from delay, by prolonging dead issues and pursuing worthless causes. No litigant can have a vested interest in delay. Unfortunately, as the present case exemplifies, the process of dispensing justice is misused by the unscrupulous to the detriment of the legitimate. The present case is an illustration of how a simple issue has occupied the time of the courts and how successive applications have been filed to prolong the inevitable. The person in whose favour the balance of justice lies has in the process been left in the lurch by repeated attempts to revive a stale issue. This tendency can be curbed only if courts across the system adopt an institutional approach which penalises



such behavior. Liberal access to justice does not mean access to chaos and indiscipline. A strong message must be conveyed that courts of justice will not be allowed to be disrupted by litigative strategies designed to profit from the delays of the law. Unless remedial action is taken by all courts here and now our society will breed a legal culture based on evasion instead of abidance. It is the duty of every court to firmly deal with such situations. The imposition of exemplary costs is a necessary instrument which has to be deployed to weed out, as well as to prevent the filing of frivolous cases. It is only then that the courts can set apart time to resolve genuine causes and answer the concerns of those who are in need of justice. Imposition of real time costs is also necessary to ensure that access to courts is available to citizens with genuine grievances. Otherwise, the doors would be shut to legitimate causes simply by the weight of undeserving cases which flood the system. Such a situation cannot be allowed to come to pass. Hence it is not merely a matter of discretion but a duty and obligation cast upon all courts to ensure that the legal system is not exploited by those who use the forms of the law to defeat or delay justice. We commend all courts to deal with frivolous filings in the same manner."



16. In spite of passing specific directions in the case of **Ramesh Chandra Sharma** (supra), that none of the similarly situated persons like the petitioners are expected to approach this Court by way of filing similar petitions again and again with regard to the same relief, which has already been given to them by granting liberty to approach the concerned Department by way of filing representation(s) and their representation(s) were directed to be decided by the concerned Department in the light of



the judgment passed in the case of **Vijay Singh** (supra), even then, the petitioners have approached this Court again by way of filing these dozens of petitions which not only have opened flood gates but also unnecessarily increased the burden of this Court, to pass the same order again and again, which are in fact not required to be passed repeatedly as the judgment passed in the case of **Vijay Singh** (supra) has been made as a *judgment in rem* in the case of **Ramesh Chandra Sharma** (supra).

17. The petitioners are unnecessarily wasting the time of other litigants who are waiting in queue for disposal of their cases for a considerable time.

18. Hence, under these circumstances, a petty symbolic amount of token cost of Rs.1000/- is imposed upon each of the petitioners for consuming the time of other litigants by way of filing these unnecessary, unwarranted similar and identical petitions.

19. Each petitioner is directed to deposit a cost of Rs.1,000/- in the Litigants Welfare Fund of Rajasthan High Court at Jaipur Bench, within a period of one week. In case, they deposit the amount of cost i.e. Rs.1000/- within the above stipulated time and furnish a receipt thereof before the concerned Department along with the representation, the concerned Department (respondent) would decide the same expeditiously as early as possible, preferably within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of the representation along with the copy of this order and receipt of deposit of amount of cost of Rs.1000/-, in the light of the





judgment passed by this Court in the case of **Vijay Singh** (supra) and **Ramesh Chandra Sharma** (supra). The disobedience of the orders of this Court by the respondents and the concerned Departments would amount to contempt of the order of this Court and the same would be viewed seriously if the similarly situated persons like the petitioners are compelled to approach this Court again for the same cause and for redressal of their same grievance.

20. Imposition of cost is necessary in such like matters in the light of the judgment of Hon'ble Apex Court in the case of **Dnyandeo Sabaji Naik** (supra) to ensure that access to justice by Courts is available to the citizens with genuine grievances. Otherwise, the doors of justice would be shut to legitimate causes simply by the weight of undeserving cases which flood the system. It is a duty and obligation casted upon all the Courts that legal system is not allowed to be exploited unnecessarily to defeat or delay the justice delivery system.

21. The reason for imposing token cost of Rs.1000/- each upon all the petitioners is to restrain them from over burdening the Courts and increasing pendency of the cases. Once the issue involved in these petitions has already been decided in their favour and they have been granted liberty to approach the concerned Department, then they are not expected to approach this Court without adjudication of their representations. Every litigation has to come to an end at some point of time and similar and identical litigation cannot be allowed to flourish again and again for the luxury





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of the litigants, who are burdening this Court unnecessarily seeking similar order again and again.

22. The order of imposing cost would not apply to those petitions which have been filed before the decision of the case of **Ramesh Chandra Sharma** (supra) i.e. the petitions filed prior to 15.07.2024.

23. With the aforesaid directions, all these petitions along with stay applications and all applications (pending, if any) stand disposed of.

24. Registry is directed to place a copy of this order separately in each connected file.

25. Needless to observe that the petitioners and all similarly situated persons would be at liberty to approach this Court in case their representation is decided adversely or if the same is not decided within a period of three months.
