In the instant matter, intensive arguments on behalf of the petitioners were heard and the same have been recorded vide order dated 09.12.2025.

Today, on 15.12.2025, the matter was listed before the Court and accordingly opportunity of hearing was given to the IG Police, Udaipur Range and the Superintendent of Police, Udaipur along with the concerned Investigating Officer as the submissions qua *malafide* and



misuse of power in the civil dispute by registering the FIR against the petitioners have been advanced against the police authorities.

In pursuance of the same, learned IGP Udaipur Range on behalf of the Superintendent of Police, Udaipur and the concerned Investigating Officer has marked presence before the Court and has submitted that preliminary enquiry as per the procedure prescribed by law were duly carried out in the instant matters. It is further submitted that the petitioners were served well in advance through e-mail before the arrest. Moreover, it is submitted that the petitioners had carried out exaggerated and bogus expenses with the amount advanced under the garb of making films.

Learned Senior Counsel, Mr. Vikas Balia, appearing on behalf of the complainant has also made intensive submissions on the same lines.

Learned counsel for the petitioners, Mr. Prem Prakash, has also put forth his submissions, in addition to the arguments advanced and recorded vide order dated 09.12.2025.

Learned counsel for the parties are at liberty to file written submissions, if any, in support of their arguments, by 16.12.2025.

Learned Public Prosecutor is directed to procure case diary, record of preliminary enquiry carried out by the authorities, copy of emails through which service has been done to the petitioners, and furnish the aforesaid before this Court, latest by 16.12.2025.
