UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. We have heard learned counsel for the parties at a considerable length. The learned Government Pleader, who has assisted this Court online, submits that out of total 741 occupiers of illegal slum structures, 740 have accepted the rehabilitation scheme and only one family comprising the petitioners is objecting to it.

2. In light of such facts, we are not inclined to interfere with the ongoing project. The special leave petition is, accordingly, dismissed.

3. However, it will not preclude the petitioners to submit a

comprehensive representation to the competent Authority for sympathetic reconsideration of the requirement for allotment of a larger area to them. Such a representation, as a matter of course, shall be examined in accordance with the scheme of rehabilitation.

4. All pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
