We have perused the additional affidavit of Shri
Shrikant Namdeo, Director of Ministry of Finance,
Department of Financial Services, New Delhi.

We expected the Ministry to come out with a proper Standard Operating Procedure for securing the data from the Debts Recovery Tribunals. The impression which one gets after reading paragraph 3 is that the Ministry wants to suggest that the staff strength of each Debts Recovery Tribunal is of 29 staff members and 1 Presiding Officer and therefore, the data can be easily provided by the Debts Recovery Tribunals.

We direct the Ministry to produce on record the data of the existing staff available with each of 39 Debts Recovery Tribunals in India.

We grant time to produce the said data till 2nd January, 2025.
