Writ Petition (Civil) praying inter alia that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed along with the WP(C) the High Court be pleased to permit the petitioner to ply the autorickshaws freely and pick up passengers from any stand in the light of Ext. P2 & P7 judgments of this honourable court according to the permit conditions, till the disposal of the Writ Petition (Civil).

This petition coming on for orders upon perusing the petition and the affidavit filed in support of WP(C) and upon hearing the arguments of M/S. P.M. SANEER & P.A. SHAJI SAMAD, Advocates for the petitioners, and of SRI. E.K. NANDAKUMAR, AMICUS CURIAE & SRI. JAI MOHAN Advocate for R1 AND SRI. T. NAVEEN, STANDING COUNSEL, KERALA STATE POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD, for R6 and SMT. M.U. VIJAYALAKSHMI, STANDING COUNSEL, COCHIN SMART MISSION LIMITED & SRI. K. JAJU BABU (SENIOR) for R7, the court passed the following:

ORDER

Mr.Jai Mohan learned counsel assisting the Amicus Curiae has filed a report in pursuance of the direction of this Court dated 08.08.2025 and given certain suggestions which are taken on record.

2. Mr. Jai Mohan pointed out provision of rule 153 keral motor vehicle rules :

Rule 153: It shall be a condition of the permit of every transport vehicle, that the holder thereof.-

- (1) Shall ensure that the vehicle is driven only by a driver duly authorised in this behalf by the Act and the rules issued thereunder,*
(2) Shall exercise effective supervision over the work of all his employees to ensure operation of the vehicle in conformity with the Act and the rules issued there under;
(3) Shall be responsible for the conduct of the driver and other employees; and
(4) Shall not use the vehicle or cause or allow it to be

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used in the commission of any offence under the Indian Penal Code or any local or special law or any statutory control order, for the time being in force.

(5) Shall display the name, age, address and contact numbers driver in white colour along with his photograph inside the vehicle at a prominent place.”

3. No doubt it is clear that in terms of Rule 153, it is the prime duty of the permit holder to see that a transport vehicle is plied only by the driver and have an effective supervision of the work and shall be responsible for the conduct of the driver or otherwise, should not allow the vehicle or cause to be used for commission of offence under the Indian Penal Code or violation of any local laws.

4. Similarly in paragraph No.13 by referring to the provisions of Section 86 of the Motor Vehicles Act, it has been stated as under:

“13. Section 86 of the MV Act empowers the Transport Authority which granted a permit may cancel the permit or may suspend it” on the following grounds:

a) on the breach of any condition specified in section

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*84 or of any condition contained in the permit, or
b) if the holder of the permit uses or causes or allows
a vehicle to be used in any manner not authorised by
the permit, or
c)
d)
e) if the holder of the goods carriage permit, fails
without reasonable cause, to use the vehicle for the
purposes for which the permit was granted, or
f)”*

5. All these conditions empowers the competent authority i.e., the Regional Transport Officer to take action against the permit holder, in case it is found that the vehicle is being plied in violation of the aforementioned rules. Thus, whenever any violation of the stage carriage vehicles is noted, the concerned RTO shall issue show cause notice to permit holders so that permit holder is sensitized about his role and terms of the provisions of the rules and sections.

6. In the operative part of the order dated 08.08.2025, this Court had mentioned as under:

“3. The crux of the dispute pertains to the time-table issued by the competent authority for, there is a very less time for the stage carriages for coverage of distance owing to the heavy traffic and to overcome

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such problem, the stage carriage bus operators' have to over-speed. In this regard, Sri.Santhoshkumar has informed that the State Transport Authority has written a letter to the Regional Transport Authority considering the provisions of Section 67(1)(d) of the Motor Vehicles Act suggesting the minimum time gap between the stage carriage permits pertaining to same route, of five(5) minutes in the city and ten(10) minutes in the Grama Panchayat. The meeting will take some time. This Court is not satisfied with the holding of the meeting as it is the need of the hour. Recently, two innocent ladies have died on account of rash and speedy driving of the stage carriages.

4. Accordingly, this Court deems it appropriate to issue directions to the RTA to convene the meeting, as expeditiously as possible, within a period of fifteen(15) days from the date of receipt of this order with regard to the fixing of the time-table as suggested in the letter of STA. Let the Amicus Curiae also come out with suggestions for safeguarding the life of the pedestrians as well as scooter/motor cyclists. "

7. It was ordered that the meeting for changing the time table should be held within fifteen(15) days from the receipt of the order.

8. Mr.Santhosh, learned Government Pleader

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submits that owing to the Onam holidays, it has been fixed for 29.09.2025. I am afraid that there is no compliance to the direction of this Court nor any application has been filed seeking extension or attenuating circumstances, it is deliberate act of contempt

9. This Court confronted the Government Pleader as to how many permit holders are plying the vehicles in the Cochin City. The answer bare minimum. It is intriguing that why steps have not been taken in respect of the stage carriages being plied within the city with a few permits to start with for the change of the time table so that the rash driving is curtailed.

10. Be that as it may. The meeting has to be called as early as possible. Accordingly it is directed to prepone the meeting from 29.09.2025 to 10.09.2025. It is made clear that if the meeting is not held, liberty is granted to the amicus curiae to bring it to the notice of this Court for appropriate orders.

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11. Mr.Jai Mohan amicus curiae informs the Court that on two roads from Banerji Road till Palarivattom, and from Medical Trust Hospital till Vyttila, there are many traffic lights which have a very less timing and very few vehicles move ahead when the green light is signalled and immediately there is again a red light. At peak hours like in the morning between 8.30 to 10.00 and evening between 5 to 7.30, all the traffic lights should be put off and the traffic should be controlled manually by installing the traffic police personal with walkie-talkies so that were able to communicate each other with regard to the congestion of the traffic on the road. These directions are issued forthwith to the City Police Commissioner for immediate compliance, particularly considering the fact that there is already an increased rush of traffic on account of the Onam holidays.
