UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

1. The applicant-complainant, who seeks cancellation of bail, granted to the petitioner (Ashish Mishra alias Monu), have relied upon some material in order to accuse the petitioner of misusing the concession of bail and violating the terms and conditions imposed upon him while granting bail.
2. On the other hand, the non-applicant/petitioner has placed on record his affidavit strongly refuting such allegations. Faced with the said affidavit, Mr. Prashant Bhushan, learned counsel for the applicant-complainant wants to place on record some more material.
3. In our considered view, the veracity, genuineness and reliability of such material can be determined by the Police Administration, who may submit a report after a fact finding enquiry.
4. Ms. Ruchira Goel, learned Standing Counsel for the State of Uttar Pradesh submits that she will collect the relevant material from both sides and entrust the same to the Superintendent of Police, Lakhimpur-Kheri, Uttar Pradesh, who may, after the fact finding enquiry, submit a report to this Court.
5. Post the matter for further consideration on 24.03.2025.
