UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following

O R D E R

1. In compliance with the order dated 09.10.2025, the State of Uttar Pradesh has filed its Status Report stating that in the course of the investigation of FIR No.658/2025, the statements of relevant witnesses have been recorded, and as regards to the alleged threat extended to a witness in the main case, the report of forensic examination is awaited. For the reason aforesaid, the investigation is still in progress. So far as the main trial in FIR No.219/2021 is concerned, 36 witnesses have already been examined, 10 have been exempted, and 85 are awaiting examination.

2. Similarly, in FIR No.220/2021, 35 witnesses are proposed to be examined out of which 25 have already deposed, and 10 are awaiting examination.

3. With regard to the oral observations made on the previous date of hearing, learned Senior Additional Advocate General for the State of Uttar Pradesh informs that 789 trials are pending before the same Presiding Officer before whom the subject trial is also undergoing.

4. List for further consideration on 19.03.2026.

5. Meanwhile, the petitioner is permitted to visit and stay at Lakhimpur Kheri, Uttar Pradesh, with his family from 25.12.2025 to 31.12.2025, subject to the same terms and conditions which have already been imposed by way of previous orders passed by this Court.
