UPON hearing the counsel, the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. We are informed by Ms. Aishwarya Bhati, learned Additional Solicitor General that the Central Government has approved the proposal for providing 27% reservation to the candidates of Other Backward Classes (Non-Creamy Layer).
2. When the Union of India has approved of the policy, we see no reason as to why it should not be implemented forthwith by the Chandigarh Administration.
3. We grant a week's time from today to comply with the recommendations of the Central Government and make necessary amendments to the Rules.
4. Needless to state that pursuant to such a decision the prospectus for admission to all the courses within the jurisdiction of Chandigarh Administration would provide for

such a reservation.

5. List next week for compliance.

6. In the event the order is not complied with, we will be constrained to take such steps as found necessary.
