O R D E R

This is a glaring case where the Court is required to take serious judicial note of. On 14.05.2025, the Special Leave Petition was dismissed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court with the following observations:-

“Heard the learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioner.

We find no error on the part of the High Court when

prayer for continuation of furlough was rejected. However, we grant time of three weeks from today to the petitioner to surrender.

Subject to what is observed above, the Special Leave Petition is dismissed.

Pending applications stand disposed of accordingly."

2. Thus, filing of the present case for the same relief is absolutely uncalled for, unwarranted and needs to be dealt with strictly.

3. Accordingly, I.A. No.138278 of 2025 seeking extension of time to surrender is rejected. It is directed that the petitioner should surrender today itself.

4. Let the matter be listed tomorrow i.e., 05.06.2025, when the Court will consider what other order needs to be passed in the facts and circumstances of the present case.
