At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioners stated that on account of the intervening arrest of the petitioners, this Special Leave Petition has been rendered infructuous insofar as the main prayer for anticipatory bail is concerned. However, he submits that response be sought from the Registrar of the Madras High Court as to under what circumstances the anticipatory bail application filed by the petitioner was not placed before the Court.

In light of the limited prayer, we deem it appropriate to issue notice to the Registrar of the Madras

High Court to explain as to why the matter of the petitioners was not placed before the Court because ultimately it is the Court which has to take a call whether the petition would be maintainable or not.
