UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

We have heard Sri P.Wilson, learned senior counsel
appearing for the petitioner-State; Ms. G.Priyadharshni,
learned counsel appearing for the first respondent; and

Sri K.M.Nataraj, learned Additional Solicitor General appearing for respondent Nos.2 and 3-Union of India.

We modify the interim order of stay granted by this Court on 11.12.2017 by directing the petitioner-State to identify the requisite extent(s) of land that is necessary for establishing Navodaya Vidyalaya in each of the Districts of the petitioner-State. The said exercise shall be carried out within a period of six weeks and place the report before this Court.

List after six weeks.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner and the representatives of the petitioner-State and the representatives of the respondent Nos.2 and 3 could have a discussion with regard to the establishment of these Schools in the petitioner-State.

Needless to observe that the report of the said consultation shall be also placed on record.

The petitioner is also at liberty to ventilate its stand in the matter to the respondent(s)-Union of India for its consideration.

We have passed the aforesaid directions only in the interest of those students who are entitled to be admitted to such schools in the State of Tamil Nadu.
