UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. Dr. Abhishek Manu Singhvi, learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner, submits that he may be permitted to withdraw this

Writ Petition with liberties (i) to file a fresh Writ Petition before this Court under Article 32 of the Constitution to challenge the constitutional validity of Sections 50 and 63 of the Prevention of Money Laundering Act, 2002 (PMLA Act); and (ii) to challenge all other actions before the High Court in appropriate proceedings.

2. With liberties aforementioned, the Writ Petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

3. Having regard to the nature of reliefs sought by the petitioner, we request the High Court to provide expeditious hearing.
