UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. In view of a rather extraordinary situation, the National

Medical Commission is directed to consider if the seat occupied by the petitioner in General Medicine can be converted as the seat for Radio Diagnosis. This direction, only to consider, is in view of the fact that the petitioner has spent six months pursuing Radio Diagnosis and also for the reason that he is meritorious.

2. We are aware of the fact that there is only one seat allocated towards Radio Diagnosis, with respect to which respondent no. 4 is now eligible. We also make it clear that our intention is not to disturb the position of respondent no. 4.

3. The National Medical Commission may instruct its counsel, who will inform this court about the advice on 29.08.2025.
