Learned Additional Solicitor General submitted that some of the States have not submitted the information to the Union of India for the purpose of compiling the data with regard to the missing children. The States are Andhra Pradesh; Arunachal Pradesh; Jharkhand, Maharashtra, Manipur, Nagaland, Punjab, Rajasthan, Telangana, West Bengal and Union Territories of Dadar and Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu; Jammu Kashmir and Puducherry.

Therefore, we expect that the respondent-Union of India will issue strong reminders to these States and Union Territories so as to submit the data to them in order to enable them to compile the data available in a single chart and place it before this Court.
