UPON being mentioned, the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. This matter has been taken up for hearing upon being mentioned by Mr. V. Giri, learned senior counsel. During the course of the hearing, Mr. Manan Kumar Mishra, learned senior counsel and Chairman of the Bar Council of India, has also entered appearance. We have impressed upon both sides to resolve the issue amicably in conformity with the order passed by this Court on 18.11.2025, whereby elections were directed to be conducted for all the State Bar Councils as per the schedule and under the supervision of the Election Committee/Supervisory Committee constituted *vide* the aforesaid order.

2. So far as the day-to-day issue that might be arising for consideration, we authorise the Supervisory Committee, headed by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Sudhanshu Dhulia, former Judge of this Court, to take appropriate decisions at its own end. It may not be necessary for the parties or the Committee to approach this Court seeking further guidance on such issues.
