O R D E R

We have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and
learned ASG appearing for the respondent.

Learned ASG appearing for the Central Bureau of
Investigation (CBI) submitted that Shri Prashant Kumar is
presently the Investigating Officer (I.O.) in the present
case and the third respondent has been transferred and he

is relieved from the present case.

Learned counsel for the petitioners sought impleadment of Shri Prashant Kumar as respondent No.4.

Accepting her plea, Shri Prashant Kumar is arrayed as respondent No.4.

Issue notice to Shri Prashant Kumar (respondent No.4).

Mr. Mukesh Kumar Maroria, learned AOR accepts notice for Shri Prashant Kumar (respondent No.4).

Petitioners' counsel to file amended memo of parties during the course of the day.

Shri H.P. Meena, Assistant Superintendent of Police (ASP), respondent No.3 is present before this Court.

Learned ASG appearing for the respondent(s) submitted that the respondents have been unable to comply with the directions issued under paragraph 32 of the order of this Court dated 15.05.2025 insofar as arrest of the persons responsible for the custodial death of Deva Pardhi is concerned owing to the fact that the Inspectors, Sanjeet Singh Mawai and Uttam Singh Kushwaha are both absconding and steps are being taken to trace them and arrest them.

He further submitted that three other officials, namely, Devaraj, Zuber Khan and Gajaraj (private person) have been arrested.

The respondent(s) shall file affidavit(s) of the concerned police officer/official(s) with regard to the steps that have been taken by the respondent(s) in order to

arrest other two officers who are stated to have been absconding. The said affidavit(s) shall be placed before this Court on or before 25.09.2025.

Petitioners' counsel to serve a copy of this Contempt Petition on learned standing counsel for the State of Madhya Pradesh so as to apprise him about the developments in the case.
