O R D E R

1. Delay condoned.
2. Permission to withdraw the present special leave petition(s) is rejected.
3. Heard learned counsel, Mr. Purushottam Sharma Tripathi, appearing for the petitioners.
4. It appears that the present petitioners had sought review of the common impugned order dated 19.10.2023, passed by the High Court of Tripura, Agartala in RFA Nos. 25 and 26 of 2022, which was earlier challenged by the petitioners before this Court by filing Special Leave

Petitions being SLP(C) Nos. 27419-27420/2023. The said special leave petitions were dismissed by the Three Judge Bench of this Court vide the Order dated 04.01.2024, without granting any liberty to the petitioners to approach the High Court by filing review petition.

5. However, the petitioners, after the dismissal of said special leave petitions, filed Review petitions before the High Court, being RP No.5 and 6 of 2024, which came to be dismissed by the High Court vide its order dated 10.07.2024, against which, the present special leave petitions are filed by the petitioners.

6. Since, the present special leave petitions have been filed against the order passed in review petitions after the dismissal of the SLPs in first round of litigation, the present special leave petitions deserve to be dismissed and are, accordingly, dismissed with a cost of Rs.50,000/- each, which shall be deposited by the petitioners before the Supreme Court Legal Services Authority within a period of 2 weeks from today.
