UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. These special leave petitions are directed against an interim order dated 24.09.2025, passed by a Division Bench of the High Court for the State of Telangana in a batch of writ appeals, the lead matter therein being Writ Appeal Nos. 1074 & 1075 of 2025. These writ appeals have been directed against the judgment dated 09.09.2025 of a learned Single Judge of the High Court, who set aside the mark lists and the ranking list of the Mains examination conducted by Telangana Public Service Commission for recruitment to Group-1 services. The learned Single Judge has further directed that either the answer scripts be re-evaluated with appropriate moderation or a fresh Mains examination be conducted. The State Public Service Commission, as well as selected candidates, are in intra-Court Appeal before the High Court, wherein *vide* impugned order the Division Bench has suspended the operative directions contained in paragraph 372 of the judgment of the learned Single Judge. However, the impugned interim order has been passed with a categorical direction that "any appointments made in the meantime shall be subject to the outcome of the instant writ appeals".

2. It may also be mentioned that the main appeals are now listed before the Division Bench on 15.10.2025.

3. Having regard to the fact that the main case, namely, the intra-Court Writ Appeals, are coming up for final hearing on 15.10.2025, we are not inclined to entertain these instant special

leave petitions and, accordingly, disposed of the same with the following clarifications:

(i) The appointments made meanwhile, as rightly directed by the Division Bench of the High Court, shall be subject to the outcome of the pending proceedings. No equitable right shall accrue in favour of the appointees.

(ii) Both sides agree to extend full cooperation to the Division Bench of the High Court for early disposal of the intra-Court Appeals.

4. We request the High Court to prioritise the hearing and make an endeavour to decide the appeals at the earliest.

5. All pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
