UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following

O R D E R

1. Shri Kapil Sibal, learned Senior Counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that the detenue has prepared certain notes and the same is required to be shared with the petitioner (wife) and as such he prays for suitable directions being issued to the respondents.
2. Shri Tushar Mehta, learned Solicitor General would fairly submit that they would have no qualms for the detenue sharing the notes with his wife (petitioner), however, any possible ground that may be urged in that regard or on the basis of same is to be staved off. At this stage, we are not expressing any opinion in that regard.
3. Learned Solicitor General would also draw the attention of this Court to the reply affidavit filed on behalf of respondent No.4 and in particular to paragraph No.18(E.).
4. Learned Senior Counsel appearing for the petitioner would further submit that in view of the subsequent development, the petitioner proposes to amend the petition by filing necessary Interlocutory Application(s).
5. At the request of learned Senior Counsel appearing for the petitioner, re-list this matter on 29.10.2025 and the notes of the detenue to be shared to petitioner shall be through Jail Superintendent.
