Heard on the question of admission and interim relief.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had earlier preferred W.P. No.17592/2025 before this Court which was disposed off by order dated 22.05.2025 directing for his representation to be decided by respondent No.2. The said order was brought to the notice of respondent No.2 on 26.05.2025 by the petitioner through an email and by way of a registered notice dated 25.06.2025. Despite the same, the representation has not been decided and despite the fact that the petitioner has preferred CONC No.3845/2025 in which by order dated 17.07.2025, notice has been issued to the respondent therein. On the contrary, award is going to be awarded in favour of respondent No.3 today.

Considering the aforesaid, issue notice to the respondents on payment of process fee by RAD within a period of three working days.

Notices be made returnable in four weeks.

Till next date of hearing, by way of interim relief, respondents No.1 and 2 are directed not to confer the Vikram Award under the category of Adventure Sports, 2023 in favour of respondent No.3.
