UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

Order dated 3rd March, 2025 reads thus:

"The learned Additional Solicitor General appearing for the first respondent pointed out that the case of the petitioner for remission shall be considered and decided within a period of two weeks from today.

We accept the said assurance and direct that the case shall be listed on 17th March, 2025."

A solemn statement on instructions of the State Government was recorded in this order. Now we are informed that Sentence Review Board is likely to consider the case of the petitioner today. The State Government has not shown elementary courtsey of making an application for grant of extension of time.

We, therefore, issue notice to the Principal Secretary of the Home Department of Delhi Government calling upon him to show why action under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 should not be initiated against him.

Notice of contempt is made returnable on 28th March, 2025. We direct the Secretary to remain present through video conference.
