UPON hearing the counsel, the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. The instant Writ Petition has been filed under Article 32 of the Constitution of India, purportedly in public interest, seeking a direction to the Union of India to

frame a comprehensive regulatory framework and license for Artificial Intelligence Tools, including those containing images, videos and audio (deepfakes) to ensure prevention and misuse of Artificial Intelligence Tools.

2. As soon as the petition was taken up, Mr. Mukul Rohatgi and Mr. Arvind P. Datar, learned senior counsel representing Meta Platforms Inc. (Respondent no.3) have informed that after considerable deliberations and multiple consultations with the stakeholders, the Union of India has formulated draft Rules, namely, Information Technology (Intermediary Guidelines and Digital Media Ethics Code) Amendment Rules, 2025, which is now available in public domain.

3. The issues raised in the instant petition are thus being effectively addressed by the Union of India, and therefore, there is no necessity for judicial intervention by this Court at this stage.

4. The Writ Petition is, accordingly, disposed of in the above terms along with pending applications.
