O R D E R

The petitioner has filed this writ petition under
Article 32 of the Constitution of India seeking the
following prayers -

"(a) Issue a Writ of Mandamus or any other appropriate Writ, Order or direction thereby declaring that the exemption of minority educational institutions from the provisions of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009, as upheld in Pramati Educational and Cultural Trust v. Union of India (2014) is unconstitutional to the extent it grants blanket immunity from RTE obligations.;

(b) Direct that all minority institutions, aided or unaided, shall comply with reasonable regulatory provisions of Section 12(1)(c) of the RTE Act 2009 ensuring quality, inclusivity and accountability.

(c) Constitute an Expert Committee to recommend a balanced framework reconciling Article 30 rights with Article 21A obligations.

(d) Pass such other and further orders as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case."

In substance, the petitioner is seeking to undo a judgment of this Court by filing a writ petition which is wholly impermissible in law.

As against the judgment of the Supreme Court, no writ petition is maintainable. This is the grossest abuse of the process of law and of this Court.

We dismiss this writ petition with cost of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees one lakh) to be paid by the petitioner herein to the Supreme Court Legal Services Committee, within a period of four weeks from today.

However, we restrain ourselves from issuing any notice to the petitioner with regard to any contempt proceedings that could have been initiated as against the petitioner herein.

Pending application(s) shall stand disposed of.
