UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. In the letter dated 24.06.2025, amongst the successive suspension notices served on the respondent, paragraph 7 recited that the CBI investigation against the respondent was "still under investigation". The High Court has interfered with the aforesaid suspension notices on the ground that there is merely a strong

suspicion of involvement of the respondent in the AgustaWestland scam.

2. Learned Additional Solicitor General of India seeks and is granted three weeks' time to produce, initially in a sealed cover, the outcome of the investigation undertaken by CBI from June 2025 till the filing of the status report.

3. Post the matter for further consideration on 09.01.2026.
