UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. We have heard the petitioner-in-person in support of the prayer made in this writ petition, purportedly filed in public interest. Mr. Mukul Rohatgi, learned senior counsel, is also on caveat on behalf of the Indigo Air Service.

2. It is pointed out, at the outset, that a PIL bearing Writ Petition (C) No.18718/2025 titled "*Akhil Rana & Anr. vs. Union of India & Ors.*" is pending before a Division Bench of the High Court of Delhi, and as recorded in order dated 10.12.2025 passed in those proceedings, a Review Committee has been appointed by the

Directorate General of Civil Aviation.

3. Since all the issues raised in this writ petition are simultaneously pending consideration before the High Court of Delhi, the petitioner also agrees that he will join the proceedings and assist the High Court of Delhi in the above-stated pending PIL proceedings. Ordered accordingly.

4. We request the High Court of Delhi to allow the petitioner to intervene in the pending proceedings and enable him to raise all the contentions sought to be raised in the instant petition.

5. It goes without saying that in the event all the grievances are not redressed, nothing precludes the petitioner or any other public-spirited person to approach this Court.

6. The Writ Petition is, accordingly, disposed of.

7. All pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
