**following
O R D E R**

1. Applications for exemption from filing Certified Copy of the Impugned judgment and official translation are allowed.
2. Issue notice, returnable in eight weeks.
3. Mr. Adarsh Upadhyay, learned counsel accepts notice on behalf of the State of Uttar Pradesh. Hence, notice to the State of Uttar Pradesh is waived.
4. Notice be issued to the remaining respondent.
5. In the meantime, by way of interim relief, subject to cooperation by the petitioner in the investigation, no coercive steps shall be taken against her in connection with FIR No. 111 of 2025 dated 27.04.2025 registered at Police Station Hazratganj,

Lucknow Central (Commissionerate Lucknow),
Uttar Pradesh.

6. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent submits that despite an order, the petitioner is not cooperating with the investigation. Considering the said statement, we direct that the petitioner shall appear before the Station House Officer of the concerned Police Station at 11.30 a.m. on 19.01.2026 and shall cooperate with the investigation. If her presence is further required, the date be given by the SHO for her presence on the next date and on that date also, she would appear at the same time.

6. Violation, if any, of the order of this Court shall be viewed seriously.
