UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following

O R D E R

1. We have heard learned senior counsel for the petitioner. Mr. K.M. Natraj, learned Additional Solicitor General has also entered appearance on behalf of the State of Rajasthan.

2. In view of the fact that the delimitation exercise is near completion and the High Court has already issued a positive direction to conclude the elections by 15.04.2026, we see no reason to entertain this special leave petition. The same is, accordingly, dismissed.

3. However, learned senior counsel for the petitioner submits that there is a genuine apprehension that the elections are likely to be further postponed. On this, Mr. K.M. Natraj states that, as per his instructions, the State Government is committed to conclude the elections by 15.04.2026.

4. In the event of any delay due to some unforeseen circumstances, the parties, for that limited purpose, may approach the High Court.

5. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand closed.
