UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

W.P.(Crl.) No.83/2025

1. In continuation of order dated 21.04.2025, it is stated by Shri Tushar Mehta, learned Solicitor General of India representing the States of Maharashtra and Assam that investigation in both the FIRs in the States of Maharashtra and Assam, *qua* the petitioner (Ranveer Gautam Allahabadia) is complete. He, however, submits that the petitioner may be required to appear till the chargesheet is filed. To this, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection and he undertakes that the petitioner will join the investigation as and when required.

2. The investigation, thus, being complete against the petitioner in both the cases, we advert to paragraph 3 of our order dated 01.04.2025 and, consequently, permit the petitioner to apply to the Maharashtra Cyber Crime Bureau to release his passport. Upon such application, let the original passport of the petitioner be returned on such reasonable terms and conditions as may be required to be complied by him. The petitioner's passport is ordered to be returned to enable him to travel abroad in light of the reasons

already noted in the order dated 01.04.2025.

3. Since investigation against the petitioner's co-accused is still going on, post both the matters for hearing on 15.07.2025.

4. At this stage, Ms. Aparajita Singh, learned senior counsel, representing M/s. Cure SMA Foundation of India states that a separate petition bearing W.P.(C) Diary No.22141/2025 has been filed invoking writ jurisdiction of this Court. However, some private respondents, required to be impleaded, could not be made party for want of their addresses. As informed by learned State counsel, most of these persons are already appearing before the Maharashtra Police in the FIR registered against them.

5. That being so, M/s. Cure SMA Foundation of India is permitted to implead the private respondents through the Commissioner of Police, Pune. Let the needful be done within this week. Cause title be corrected accordingly.

6. Post the W.P.(C) Diary No.22141/2025 filed by M/s. Cure SMA Foundation on 05.05.2025.
