O R D E R

After having heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, we find that the maximum which can be considered is whether the penalty imposed is disproportionate. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner states that the petitioner is willing to give an undertaking that he will not hereinafter indulge in objectionable activities. In any case, even if we are

persuaded to consider the case for modifying the penalty,
the issue of back-wages will not arise.

As none appears for the respondents, we direct the
petitioner to serve the notice on the standing counsel
for the respondent-State which is made returnable on 17th
December, 2024.
