UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following

O R D E R

1. The petitioner seeks quashing/clubbing of the following three FIRs: (i) FIR No. 78/2025; (ii) FIR No. 19/2025; and, (iii) FIR No. 60/2025.

2. It may be seen that all the FIRs have been registered in the State of Uttar Pradesh. We are, therefore, of the considered view that the petitioner should approach the High Court for the same relief sought in the instant Writ Petition. The Writ Petition is accordingly dismissed.

3. Having regard to the urgency involved, we direct the Registrar (Judicial) of the High Court that if any petition is filed by the

petitioner, the same be listed within three days of filing of the said petition.

4. If the petitioner is already on bail, his arrest shall remain stayed for two weeks to enable him to approach the High Court.
