1. Mr. Nishant Bora, learned counsel for the applicant invited Court's attention towards the previous order(s) passed by this Court and the order of Hon'ble the Supreme Court dated 30.07.2025 in Special Leave Appeal (Crl.) No. 10758/2025, which emanated from the order of Gujarat High Court passed in similar circumstances qua the present applicant and submitted that the Gujarat High Court has extended applicant's interim bail upto 21.08.2025. He prayed that the interim bail granted to the applicant by this Court be also extended appropriately.
2. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the medical reports, which the applicant has placed on record, we are of the view that it would be appropriate that applicant's medical condition be got examined by a Medical Board to be

constituted by Medical Superintendent or any other competent authority of Civil Hospital, Ahmedabad. The Board to be constituted shall include at least two Cardiologists and one Neurologist of professor rank.

3. On production of the web copy of this order, the Medical Superintendent of the Civil Hospital, Ahmedabad shall constitute the Medical Board within a period of three days and examine the applicant on all parameters, including his health concerns relating to Cardiac and Neuro problems. The Board shall also report as to whether the applicant's medical condition requires hospitalization or continuous medical attendance.

5. The report be sent to the Registrar (Judicial) of this Court on its email (reg-judicial-rhc@hcraj.nic.in) and a copy thereof be handed over to the applicant or his authorized representative.

6. List this case on 27.08.2025.

7. The period of temporary bail of the applicant extended by order dated 08.07.2025 is further extended up to 29.08.2025.
