O R D E R

I.A. No. 207659/2025, for deletion of proforma parties, is allowed.

Amended memo of parties shall be filed before the next date of

hearing.

Issue notice, returnable on 08.10.2025.

Mr. Kunal Mimani, learned counsel, and Ms. Preetika Dwivedi, learned counsel, who are present in Court, waive service and accept notice on behalf of the State of West Bengal and West Bengal Central School Service Commission (WBCSSC) respectively. Hence, notice need not be served on the said respondents.

Notice upon the unrepresented respondents shall be served by all modes, including *dasti*.

Counter affidavit/reply shall be filed by the contesting respondents within three weeks.

Rejoinder thereto, if any, may be filed within two weeks thereafter.

Learned senior counsel appearing for the WBCSSC states, on instructions, that the list of tainted candidates who were selected, whose selection has been set aside by the High Court and confirmed by this Court, would be placed in the public domain, that is, on the website of the WBCSSC within seven days.

We take the statement on record.

Learned senior counsel further states that all the petitioners herein have already submitted their applications and that they would be permitted to appear in the examinations scheduled to be held on 07.09.2025 and 14.09.2025, without insisting upon their complying with the newly introduced eligibility criteria of securing 50% minimum marks in graduation and post-graduation under the West Bengal School Service Commission (Selection for

Appointment to the Posts of Assistant Teachers for Upper Primary Level of Classes [except Work Education and Physical Education], Classes IX-X and Classes XI-XII) Rules, 2025.
