About CML

The National Law University Odisha, Cuttack (NLUO) established the Centre for Maritime Law(CML) in 2015 with an aim to build a center of excellence and research in the field of maritime law in India.

The Centre identifies first and foremost, that the statutes which govern maritime law were adapted from foreign states and these statutes don't address the concerns pertaining to the field appropriately, as the Indian trade practices are relatively different from those foreign states. Also, under the Indian maritime law regime, there has been a lack of timely amendments and proper implementation and hence most of the laws are outdated and are not equipped to deal with modern complications. The Centre is currently working on Indian statutes, case laws, international treaties and conventions pertaining to maritime law and seeks to crystallize the current maritime jurisprudence in India.

Course Details

About the Course

The Centre for Maritime Law at NLUO presents a 3-credit course on Maritime Laws and Practice, offering a deep dive into the essential aspects of maritime law. The course covers critical areas such as the carriage of goods by sea, international law and the law of the sea, shipping contracts, marine insurance, and maritime dispute resolution.

This program combines theoretical understanding with practical insights, enabling participants to explore the interplay between domestic statutes, international conventions, and evolving industry practices. The course includes engaging discussions, case studies, and practical exercises to develop problem-solving skills and expertise in legislative interpretation and dispute resolution.

Guided by resource persons with extensive knowledge and experience, the course aims to prepare participants for the dynamic challenges of maritime law. The program also offers a platform for participants to gain practical exposure and refine their legal and analytical skills.

Ideal for students, legal professionals, and scholars, this course provides an opportunity to understand and contribute to the development of maritime jurisprudence in India.

Course Details

Mode

The course shall be conducted in a hybrid manner, that is, both virtually and physically.

Classes and Evaluation

The course will consist of 45 hours of classes. Resource persons with extensive experience in maritime law and practice will lead interactive lectures and practical sessions. The format of the classes will be hybrid. For NLUO students the format is Physical and for non-NLUO students the format is virtual.

Evaluation will be based on the student's attendance, engagement during sessions, and performance in a written examination and a Negotiation examination. To qualify for certification, participants must maintain a minimum attendance of 75%. The grading scheme will be based on percentage.

Further, the top 2 candidates will receive an internship opportunity in Callidus Legal and VJ Mathew & Co. respectively.
