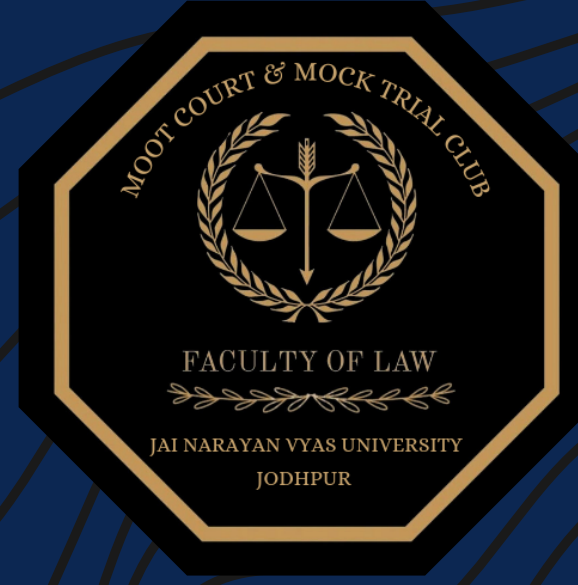

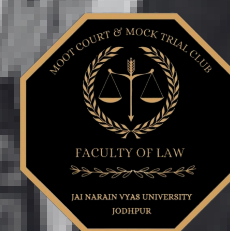

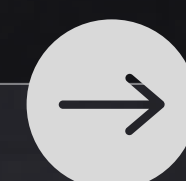
ABOUT FACULTY

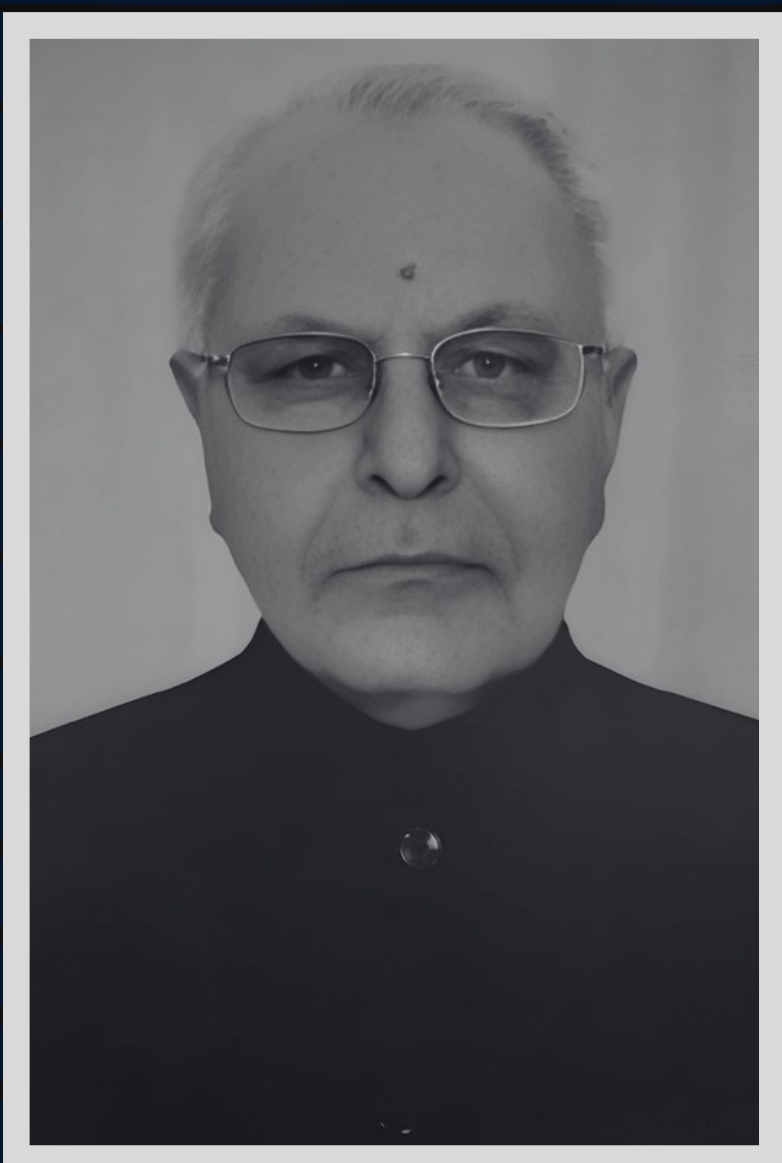

Shri B.L. Purohit was born in the year 1925 at Bikaner. He completed his high School in the year 1943 from Rampuriya Jain College, Bikaner and B.Sc from Dungar College, Bikaner in the year 1945. Right from the initial days he was a vibrant personality in the making not only excellent in studies but also in extracurricular activities. He did his LLB from Rajputana University in year 1949. He was enrolled as an Advocate in year 1953 and in the year 1959 he became Member of the Bar Council of Rajasthan. Thereafter he became unopposed President of Rajasthan High Court Advocate Association in the year 1977. Mr. B.L. Purohit became designated Senior Advocate in the year 2011 and thereafter he was active in practice upto the year 2016. Mr. Purohit possessed a rare combination of unquestionable integrity, sterling character and high moral values. He maintained highest standards in his professional as well as personal life. He was a symbol of courtesy and culture, both inside as well as outside the Court. Late Shri B.L. Purohit was self made person. His hard labour and dedication spoke volumes about his personality and he became prominent lawyer of Rajasthan High Court. He was an astute Advocate in Civil Law, Revenue Law, Mining Law, Ceiling Law and Electricity Law through which he built his towering personality among lawyers. Mr. Purohit always gave sagacious advice to the young lawyers which helped them in shaping their future. It will be appropriate to say that Mr. Purohit was embodiment of wisdom not only by his work but also by his demeanour and presence in the Court rooms and corridors. 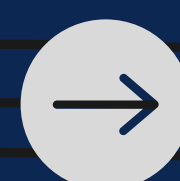


MCMT CLUB

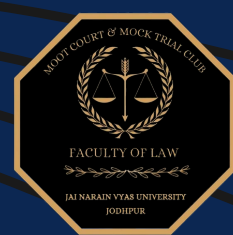

ABOUT JODHPUR

Jodhpur's history began in 1459 when Rao Jodha, a Rajput chief of the Rathore clan, founded the city and the Marwar kingdom, naming it after himself, building the majestic Mehrangarh Fort as its stronghold. It served as the capital of the Kingdom of Marwar, a powerful Rajput state that flourished under Rathore rule, later becoming a significant princely state under the British Raj before joining India.

Jodhpur, Rajasthan's second-largest city, is known as the "Blue City" for its vivid indigo-painted homes and "Sun City" for its sunny, desert climate. Founded in 1459, it features the majestic Mehrangarh Fort, Umaid Bhawan Palace, and bustling markets for textiles, spices, and handicrafts. Located in the Thar Desert, it is a major hub for tourism and Rajasthani culture.

The Rajasthan High Court in Jodhpur is the principal seat and highest judicial body in the state, established on August 29, 1949, under the Rajasthan High Court Ordinance, 1949. A new, modern building was inaugurated on December 7, 2019, to house the court. It currently has a sanctioned judge strength of 50, with an actual strength of 42.

Jodhpur's famous restaurants beautifully blend royal heritage with rich flavors, making the city a true paradise for food lovers. Renowned places such as RAAS Haveli, Pal Haveli, and Mehrangarh Fort Rooftop Restaurant offer breathtaking views of the mighty fort along with authentic Rajasthani and continental cuisine. Khaas Bagh is admired for its heritage ambience and traditional recipes, while Bal Samand Lake Palace (Balsam) provides a serene dining experience surrounded by royal gardens. Adding to the city's grandeur, Umaid Bhawan Palace restaurants deliver world-class fine dining with unmatched luxury and hospitality. Together, these iconic restaurants showcase Jodhpur's regal charm, warm hospitality, and timeless culinary traditions.

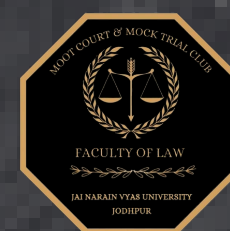

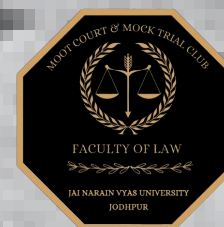
