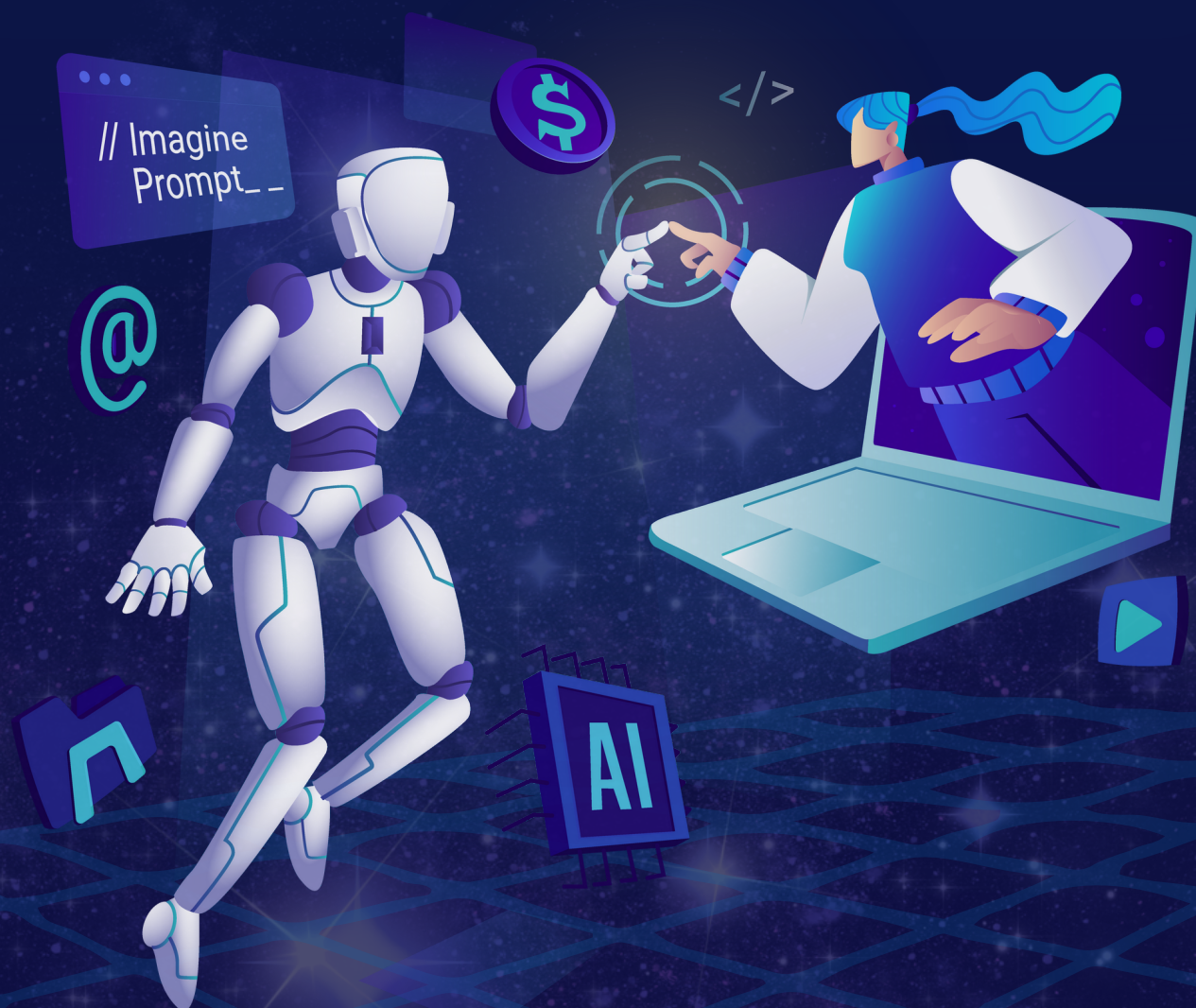

He has successfully defended leading technology companies, including Google Pay, in a landmark regulatory and privacy case, and a major social media platform in one of India's earliest writ petitions challenging account suspension under terms of service.

As a former visiting faculty member at the National Law School of India University (NLSIU), Bengaluru and a Partner at Luthra and Luthra Law Offices, he has generously shared his knowledge of platform regulation and intermediary liability, shaping the next generation of legal minds in the field of technology law.
