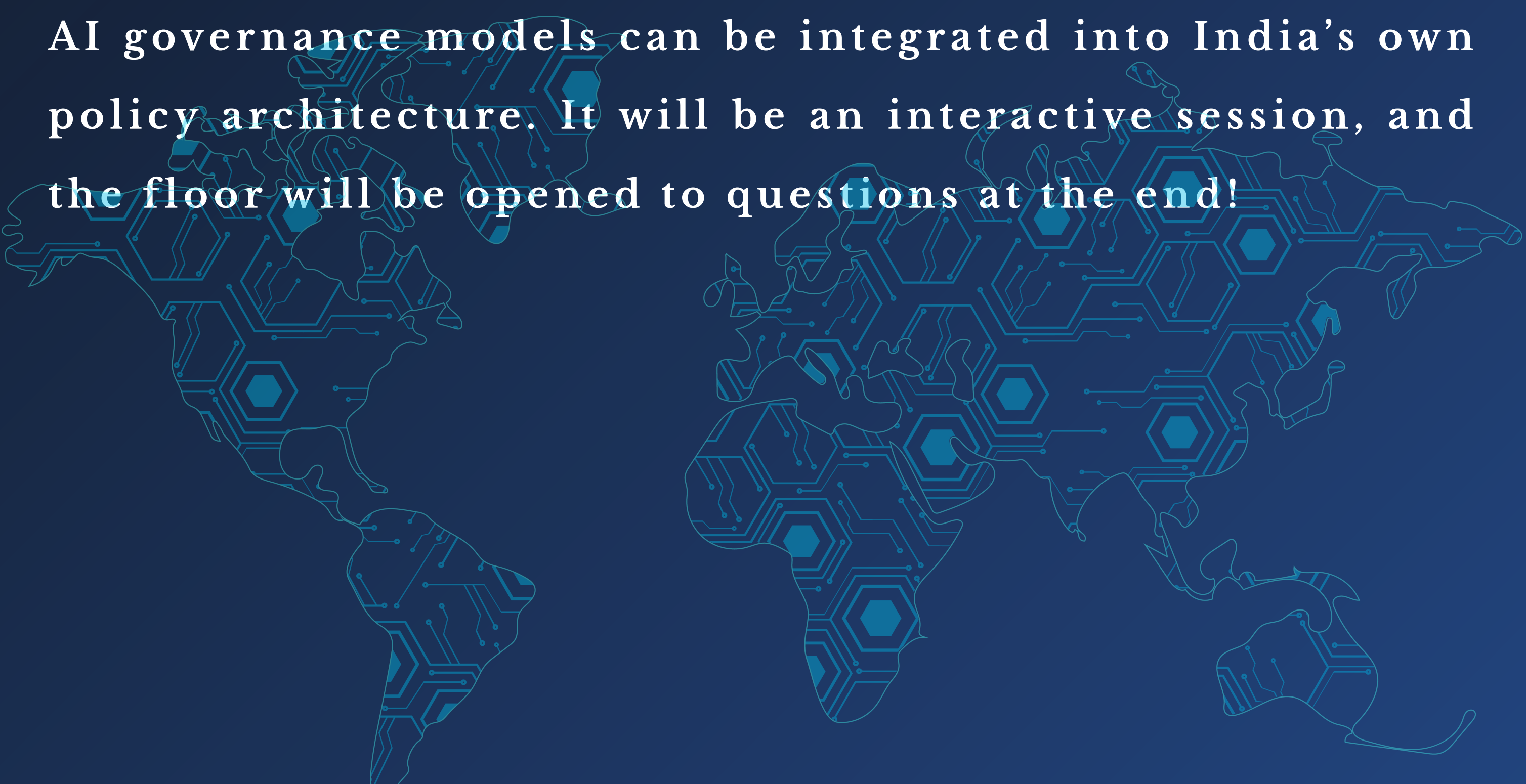

- A practical segment on building a career in tech regulation skills to develop, kinds of exposure needed, emerging sub-fields, and clearing common misconceptions law students have about tech-law practice.
